## Malakoff Young Farmers Scholarship

The Malakoff Young Farmers will give at least two scholarships to deserving Malakoff High School graduating senior, FFA members. The amount will be determined each year in February by the scholarship committee based on available funds.

To apply for this scholarship, the student must complete the attached application and submit for review no later than the 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday of April, each year. **April 19, 2013**

Carefully follow the instructions stated below. Fill in or check all blanks that apply. If any part is incomplete in the application it will be rejected.

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior of Malakoff High School.
2. Applicant must be a member in good standing with the FFA.
3. Applicant and/or parent/guardian must have worked or helped with at least one event each semester there is an event available to work, i.e. Rodeo, barrel race, chili dinner, auction, roping, meals, etc.)
4. Funds will be paid in one (1) lump sum directly to the appropriate university, college, or technical/trade school after the recipient has furnished proof of registration.
5. Scholarship funds may be used towards tuition, fees, and books/supplies only.
6. Scholarship funds must be used within four (4) years from date of graduation.

- Accompanied by a high school transcript
